

Décor Elements Used on Linen Albums ~ by Selene Kempton

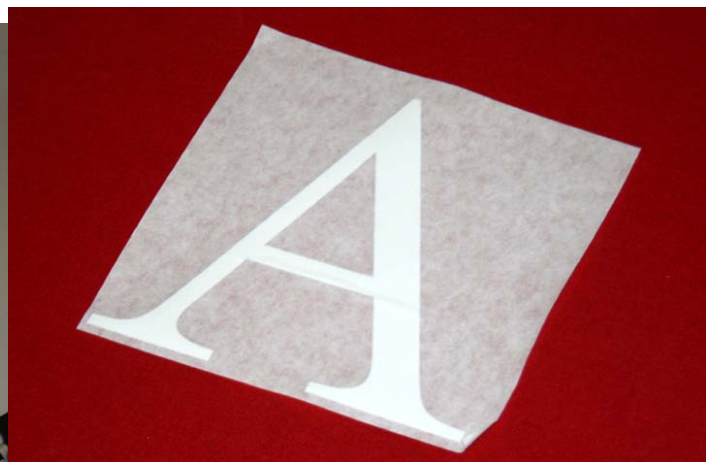
Items you will need:

- Stampin' Up! Album
- Heat Tool
- Décor Elements
- Paint Brush
- Craft Ink (regal rose used here)
- Sponge dauber
- Chunky Glitter



Directions:

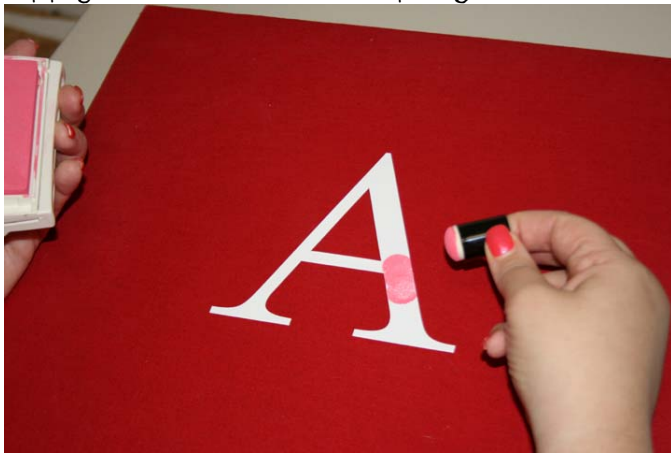
1. Peel back the heavy glossy side of our décor elements transfer sheet and attach the element to the front of your album.



2. Peel back the sticky side of the transfer sheet (use your fingers to attach any pieces that pop up).



3. Apply craft ink with a sponge dauber (note it will be QUITE wet!).



4. Pour Heat and stick powder over your image. Use the powder pal to catch the excess. I found that the powder stuck to my album, so I used a paint brush to remove any excess powder before heating.



5. Use a heat tool to heat the powder ONLY until it changes color. **note: Do not overheat or the powder will no longer be sticky!) Then Apply Chunky Glitter.



6. Re-Heat your glittered Décor elements artwork to set the heat and stick powder so it's permanent. *(Be careful when heating not to overheat, it's just like regular embossing!)
7. Then, finish decorating your album. Please note I added an extra photo at the bottom so you can see that the décor elements does not appear to be lifting at all. It looks so sweet on the album. My daughter has already claimed this album as hers because of the glittery "A".
